Early return from camp

Last night the Country Fire Authority (CFA) was called to our Garema-Dumont Outdoor Education Campsite after a flare-up was discovered.

The College immediately acted in line with expectations:

- Staff responsible on site ascertained the safety of students and staff and determined the safest course of action was to evacuate temporarily, which was done.
- Staff responsible liaised with relevant emergency services who attended the incident and following their action deemed it 'all clear.'
- Staff responsible contacted relevant members of College Leadership Team.

Due to the nature of the incident, the disruption to the camp and forecast weather conditions this week, it was determined that it was best, that on this occasion, students make an early return to the College.

Parents were immediately notified and students arrived safely back at the College just before midnight.

The safety and wellbeing of students and staff is paramount at all times. The College and staff enacted our emergency response and responded to this incident in line with established procedures and expectations.
