

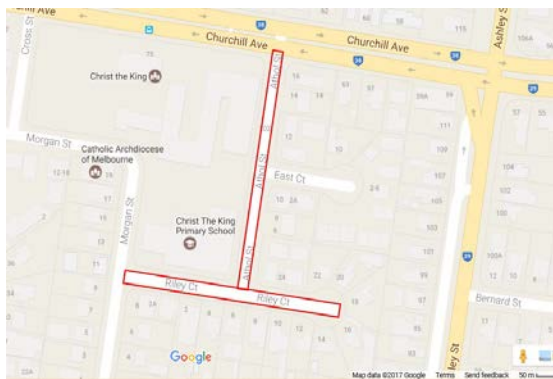

Dear Parents / Guardians,

**RE: Water main replacement along Riley Court and Athol Street**

City West Water will construct a new water main in Riley Court and Athol Street commencing next Wednesday, 22 February. Works are expected to take approximately three weeks.



*Affected streets outlined in red.*

Working hours will be between 7:30am and 4:00pm Monday to Friday, with some construction on weekends.

Caroline Chisholm Catholic College has been informed that Christ the King campus will not be directly impacted by the works.

However, local streets may be partially blocked off as a result.

Please be mindful that the works will impact drop off / pick up during school hours and we encourage you to allow extra time during this time.

## WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT

### Riley Court and Athol Street Braybrook

As part of City West Water's Water Main Renewal Program, we are constructing a new water main in Riley court and Athol st . This program is designed to improve water supply reliability for our customers.

The contractor performing these works will be DKM Utility Services. Construction works are scheduled to begin on the week of 22/02/2017 and be complete within approximately 3 working week. Working hours will be between 7.30am and 4.00pm Monday to Friday and there may be some construction on weekends.

#### TEMPORARY WATER SUPPLY

- To minimise disruption to your water supply during the works, your residence may be supplied via a temporary water service laid along the front of properties
- Please ensure you provide access to your water meter during the works or organise access with the contractor to connect and disconnect the temporary service
- Heavy duty recycled rubber ramps may also be provided across your driveway. Please ensure vehicles travel slowly over the ramp without stopping or starting
- **CAUTION: Water from your cold tap will be warmer than usual due to the temporary service and will significantly increase on the hot days**

#### TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT / CONDITIONS

- Traffic management will be set up prior to commencement of works.

#### DISRUPTIONS TO WATER SUPPLY

- You will be notified with a card in your letterbox at least 48 hours before any planned disruptions to your water supply
- Disruptions will generally be less than three hours and every effort will be made to minimise this
- You will be able to obtain water from a tap on a fire hydrant in a nearby street during any disruption during the works. For the location of this tap, please call our Operational Control Centre on 132 642
- Your property will be connected to the new water main as soon as the work is completed
